Purpose of the Service

TrainerText Library is a membership-based online platform providing access to a curated library of educational books. All library content is produced and uploaded by trained teachers associated with the organisation. The site also includes assessment dashboards accessible to teacher users only.

User Base

Teachers, parents, and school students.

Access Model & Registration

The service is not publicly accessible; access is restricted to registered members.

Illegal Content Harms & Risk Assessment

Risks include CSAM, grooming, terrorism content, hate content, fraud, and threats.

Likelihood across all categories assessed as Very Low; Severity ranges from Medium to Severe.

Existing Safety Controls

Controls include curated content, access control, no user-generated content, and restricted dashboards.

Additional Mitigations

Includes AUP development, reporting mechanism, governance enhancements, and future change reviews.

Record Keeping & Review

Annual review, logging, and safety lead responsibilities.

Summary

The platform presents very low risk of illegal content appearing due to controlled authoring, membership access, and absence of communication tools.
